AiM Teachers:

Please read carefully. There are new procedures for this year's Theory Exam.

Written Exam

- Written exams will be given by the student's teacher. If at all possible, the student should take the written exam at their teacher's home.

Keyboard Skills/Aural Skills Exam

- Keyboard Skills and Aural test will be given by a judge who is not the student's teacher.
 - In person at the Judge's home or at a place that is convenient for the judge to administer the test.
 - Students will be assigned to the Judge.
 - Judge will schedule the exam time.
- If necessary, virtual exams can be arranged.
- One parent needs to accompany the student into the judge's home for safety reasons.
